

Differential/Transfer Case Fluid

Why Change Differential/Transfer Case Fluid?

Over time:

- Gear oil becomes dirty and breaks down due to heat and mileage
- Moisture can enter system reducing the effectiveness of the gear oil

Benefits of Differential/Transfer Case Fluid Service

- Prevents abnormal gear wear due to poor lubrication
- Prevents gear overheating

How Often Should Fluid be Changed?

- Follow manufacturer recommendation
- In the absence of manufacturer recommendation, every
 12,000 miles or 12 months if doing a lot of towing
- Otherwise 36,000 miles for standard gear oil, 50,000 miles of synthetic gear oil
- Hondas or Acuras with 4WD or AWD every 15,000 miles
